The Church Nursery - Cornerstone

A minimum of two adult nursery workers (18 years or older) will be on duty and the Nursery Coordinator will make every effort to have a third helper as well. The third helper may be younger than 18 if two adults are present.

Nursery Guidelines. No one should be in the nursery except the nursery workers and the children being brought to the nursery for care. Ages for the nursery are birth through 3 years of age and should not be in the nursery without a nursery worker present. The nursery is not to be used as a playroom for older children at any time. Nursery is to be kept locked until Nursery workers arrive.

A nursery worker should never be alone with a child in a restroom. Have two teachers escort a group of children to the restroom. If a single child needs to go, have the volunteer stand outside with the door propped open.

Gather information and design guidelines that are consistent with your diocesan or judicatory policies regarding healthy church practices and “Safe Guarding God’s Children.” All who work and volunteer in the nursery should attend a Safe Church Training and have a background check before starting the position. Establish a “Nursery Policy” for your church.
