Grammatical Error Definition and Examples

Almost 10% of the grammatical errors made by the less proficient students in this study are verb form errors (77 errors or 9.88%). There are more errors of omission (39 instances) and addition (28 instances) than misinformation (8 instances) and misordering (2 instances).

According to Brown (2000), a "mistake" (in performance) refers to a performance error in that it is the learner's failure to utilize a known system correctly, while an "error" (in competence) is a noticeable deviation from the adult grammar of a native speaker, reflecting the interlanguage competence of the learner.

The research findings revealed that 2,218 grammatical errors were found in both of two main types: morphological errors (81.97%) and syntactic errors (18.03%). main types, there were 32 error sub-types. respectively. intralingual and developmental errors had influences on the errors made in the writing.

As to the frequency findings of grammatical errors, it was found that the totality of grammatical errors are 456 times, which divide into seven categories. The highest frequency of grammatical (syntax and morphology) errors is verb tense and form errors, which take up 22% of the totality errors.

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
